



3ds Max training course

This course provides the foundational skills for using 3ds Max. You learn how to use AutoDesk 3ds Max's tools for creating architectural modeling and animations. This 3ds Max training class includes detailed coverage of the interface and proper workflow for setting up 3ds Max projects. Regularly scheduled public courses also covers introduction to animation, and foundations with cameras, lighting, and rendering; although animation can be excluded from private courses if desired.

This course is designed for professionals who are seeking to learn 3D tools for creating renderings, whether for architectural, engineering, interior design, game design, or animation. No previous experience with 3D is needed.
